Sun. August 18: Restrictions for Sunday will be from noon until approximately 3:30. There will be a short window around 1:30-1:45 between races that boats will be allowed to enter and leave the harbour. Any emergencies that would require that the access to the harbour be open should be requested via the Coast Guard on marine 16.
