We are looking into the feasibility of using a meter to indicate voltage flow into the water surrounding the docks.


What's Happening

The Club is in disrepair. The structure itself needs work. Things have been patched and jury rigged to the point that they have to be either over hauled completely or replaced. Point in fact. The roof can no longer be patched. Nor can it be roofed over according to building codes. It has to be stripped down, wood replaced and a new roof put on. So far the structure is fine but if we wait even another year, there is a real possibility that the support for the roof will have to be replaced. Anyone who does carpentry knows, that once you have to replace joists and rafters the price increases drastically. Who is going to do the work? With our ageing membership we will have to contract it out. The will to help is strong, but it is no longer physically feasible to expect the members to contribute to the extent needed to maintain this Club. Plumbing, electrical, painting basic carpentry, cleaning, fine all within the realm of possibility. Standing on a roof ripping off shingles is not. We need to increase our cash flow by increasing fees, so we can afford to hire the work out to the professionals who have the ability to get it done correctly and safely, without endangering the health and welfare of the membership.
