I will comment that when there was a problem Dan contacted a professional (Proby Robert Peterson) to keep the water flowing. Kudos There are two dates to keep in mind: October 12th and the 19th. We cannot rely on the weather to remain tranquil. We will need the cooperation of the whole Club for these two dates.

The 12th is the designated day for Bubbler installation this is a big job requiring a lot of hands. Therefore all boats need to be removed from their slips in order for our efforts to be effective. Additionally all uprights and ladders are to be removed before closing. When securing said items to your finger pier, keep in mind the the Bubbler crew need the use of the finger piers.
