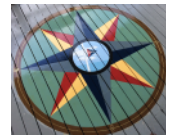

Sailboat Racing Series: Trophies are being updated for distribution at the Fall Banquet.

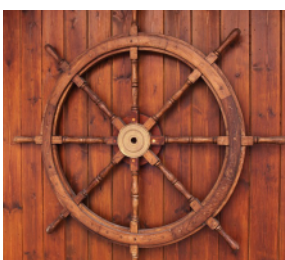
Recreation: Several members attended the Dunkirk Lighthouse Haunted Tour and all had a special, interesting and fun time. Highly recommended!

Facilities:

I am happy to report the water line project is complete. All the docks and the house have been re plumbed. There are a couple of additional connections to be made, the line to the pump out, the line to the T at the end of North dock and the two sink units. These will be completed next spring. I want to express my sincere appreciation to all who helped on this project. It was a major undertaking with about 250 hours of combined work hours. Those who helped did a fantastic job. Our club infrastructure has been dramatically improved with this project. Thanks again for all your work.

I also want to remind everyone of a couple of dates:

10/12 - Installation of the bubbler system. We need many hands to complete this job. We will start at **8:30**. Please make sure all boats that draw **5 feet** or more are out of the water by this date.

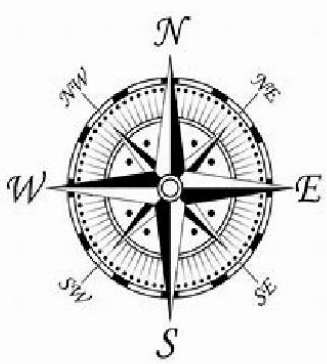
10/19 - Closing. We will need help on this date to shut off and blow out all the water lines and to secure everything in side the clubhouse. Again many hands will be appreciated. We will start at **8:30**. Please make sure all ladders and uprights are removed from your finger piers prior to that date.

As far as ladders go if you haven't secured yours already you can mark them so you know which one is yours and put them on on the west or north dock common area. If we stack them together we can tie them all up on the **19th**. Your uprights can be secured directly to your finger pier. I have had luck tying them to my pier. I know others screw them down. Whichever way you choose please make sure it is done prior to the **19th**.

If you have any questions or concerns please don't hesitate to contact me.

Did You Know...?

Facilities is once again stressing the importance of removing any and all pieces of wood, metal etc. that are attached to your finger pier. Leaving these items in the water makes the structure of the dock more susceptible to ice damage. Last year it was suggested that any one in violation of removing said items would be paying an additional fee [to be determined] if facilities has to remove these items. The team of volunteers closing the Club have enough to do without taking on responsibility that is ultimately the individual members. Please be considerate and remove all uprights and ladders connected to your finger pier. See above for timetable.
