Damage from December storm was significant but not unbearable. Lots of spots where the deck is missing. Plastic decking that is over the old wood which was not treated is warping and becoming loose under the plastic decking. Sections will have to be taken off to replace the lower layer before fixing the top. Switching to a face nail system that holds better. Line to road also needs to be repaired, as well as some finger piers that need to be rebuilt. It was also suggested to raise the bubbler pumps as well to keep them out of the water from the lake seiches. Power outlets height seem to be ok, it is the spray that trips many of them. The bubbler system removal was discussed as well. We are at the point where we have used these enough years that we are learning every season the best setup and removal strategies. Brett has been working along with Dan to plan for this.
