Mission of the LRP:

- Envision DYC facilities requirements and changes, 1-2, 5, 10 and 20 years from now
- Plan for potential future infrastructure changes to clubhouse, docks, utilities, etc.
- Set current and future infrastructure standards for repair and/or replacement projects
- Recommend/manage short term projects (1-2 years) that improve the esthetics, safety, and/or usefulness of the DYC clubhouse and docks (improvement vs repair)
- Help manage long range capital budget planning for major infrastructure changes/replacement.

Docks:

- Finalize details for the ramp projects for presentation to the members at the November Annual Meeting
- Pushing the 2nd ramp project to 2025 for potential of volunteer availability
- Tom S will present.

Electric:

- Discussed a budget and project for next year to start changing electric infrastructure for west dock as an upgrade and learning experience.
- Project will need approximately \$8,000 budget and Brett will present this project at the annual meeting.

Budget:

- Discussed the need for capital budgeting.
- The Board used to ask all committee leaders to submit a budget for the upcoming season that the board could evaluate.
- A further suggestion was to have a capital budget that looked at replacement timing for all our assets and budgets that accumulated the necessary funds over time to replace them (for example: our roof, ice machine, outboards, barge, etc.)
- Also discussed the possibility of charging for electric use separate from slip fees.

2023 Planning: Repair docks as appropriate, evaluate bubbler system, consider eliminating aging and rotting infrastructure and docking on West dock. Make the entry to the clubhouse and docks ADA compliant through use of ramps, set up Club for remote virtual meetings, potentially set up cameras for Club member access online.
