A Message from the Commodore – Tom Safford

As the winter lingers on, the DYC Board and Long Range Planning Committee have been busy planning our projects and events for the coming season.

Fred Smith-Dengler and team have been diligently watching ice damage to our facilities and assessing what it will take to make repairs once we can safely gain access to the club. There is considerable damage to the wing docks and parts of the main dock, so work parties will be necessary as early as possible this spring. He is also making plans to fix the barge pontoons so it will be ready.

We will be talking to bubbler contractors to look at a design improvement to reduce the ice damage to our docks and pilings.

The plan for the Main Walkway project hit a snag in that the same equipment, early schedule and member volunteers are needed to repair the docks as well as build the walkway, so we are busy looking at alternative options, with the first priority being fixing the docks.

The Dock Improvement project will continue by finishing the west dock with electricity and water now that parts we were waiting for are available, then moving onto the N Dock.

Kirk Frey will start planning the Bathroom Remodel for the clubhouse and I am sure he will welcome volunteers to his committee.

This year we will update our Bylaws and Guidelines manual and reprint it as it has been several years since an update.

I look forward to seeing everyone at the club this year for another great boating season!
