

There has been discussion regarding a second floor addition to the Club building. Exploring this possibility has some costs in the form of engineering studies, design and permitting. Due to the costs and scope of the project, the decision to proceed with investigation should be made by the membership. The members will be presented with cost estimates at the annual meeting and will be asked to make a decision whether to spend money to further the possibility of a second floor addition.




