Nautical News February 2015

Commodore Paul Wallenhorst opened the February Board Meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silence for Ed Will. The Club will donate \$25 to the Dunkirk Free Library in Ed's memory. Commodore Wallenhorst appointed Carl Bjurlin, with the Board of Director's approval, as the new Dockmaster per the DYC By-law in Article 7 Section 5.

Vice Commodore Robyn Beardsley announced that the labels for the work hour book for the new season are ready. She will be preparing new slip fee envelopes for visitors that will include detachable stubs to be displayed on visiting boats. This will create better accountability for visitors docked at the Club.

Treasurer Carl Waclawski reported that dues are coming in and that the property taxes, association dues and water bill have all been paid and the checkbook is balanced. The deadline for dues payment is February 28th or a \$50 late fee will be charged.

Facilities Chair Larry DeJonghe noted that the Club opening is set for Saturday, May 9th. He noted that we will be needing power washers to clean the docks and is asking that anyone who can help out and/or supply us with a power washer to please contact him.

Membership Chair Bill Wright brought forward requests for inactive status from Brian Armstrong and Colleen Wright. Both requests were approved by the Board. Bill said that Gary Deckard is scheduled to be introduced as a new member at the next Board Meeting in March. Probationary members Bill McClintic and Jay Stoltenberg were granted senior membership status by the Board.

Dockmaster Carl Bjurlin stated that he spoke with Craig Lyford who will be forming a committee to handle the deck replacement. Craig is looking for volunteers to work on this project.

Recreation and Race Chair Kathy Fox said that there is a need for committee boats for sailing races, especially on holidays and for the Commodore's Party and Champaign Race. Power boaters who may be interested are encouraged to participate in training that will be set up to learn the rules and flags for committee boats. Kathy added that she has been in contact with Phil Spencer from the Sugarbush Yacht Club in Port Colborne regarding the Lake Erie International (LEI) Cruise. A date of July 18th has been set for the LEI with a rain date of July 25th. She added that the members of Sugarbush expressed interest in it being more of a social event than a race since they enjoy coming to the DYC.

Education Committee Chair Donna Bjurlin said that sailing classes are being set up through JCC and will be held from July 6-10th. Hank and Julie Danielson will be the instructors again this year.

House Chair Carl Lis procured estimates for new carpeting in the clubhouse. It was suggested that club members perform the labor, providing we can get members with the experience and knowledge to volunteer to do the job. The Board will decide on the carpet choice and installation at the meeting in March. Carl added that he and Susan would like to conduct another AED class this season to which the Board agreed.
