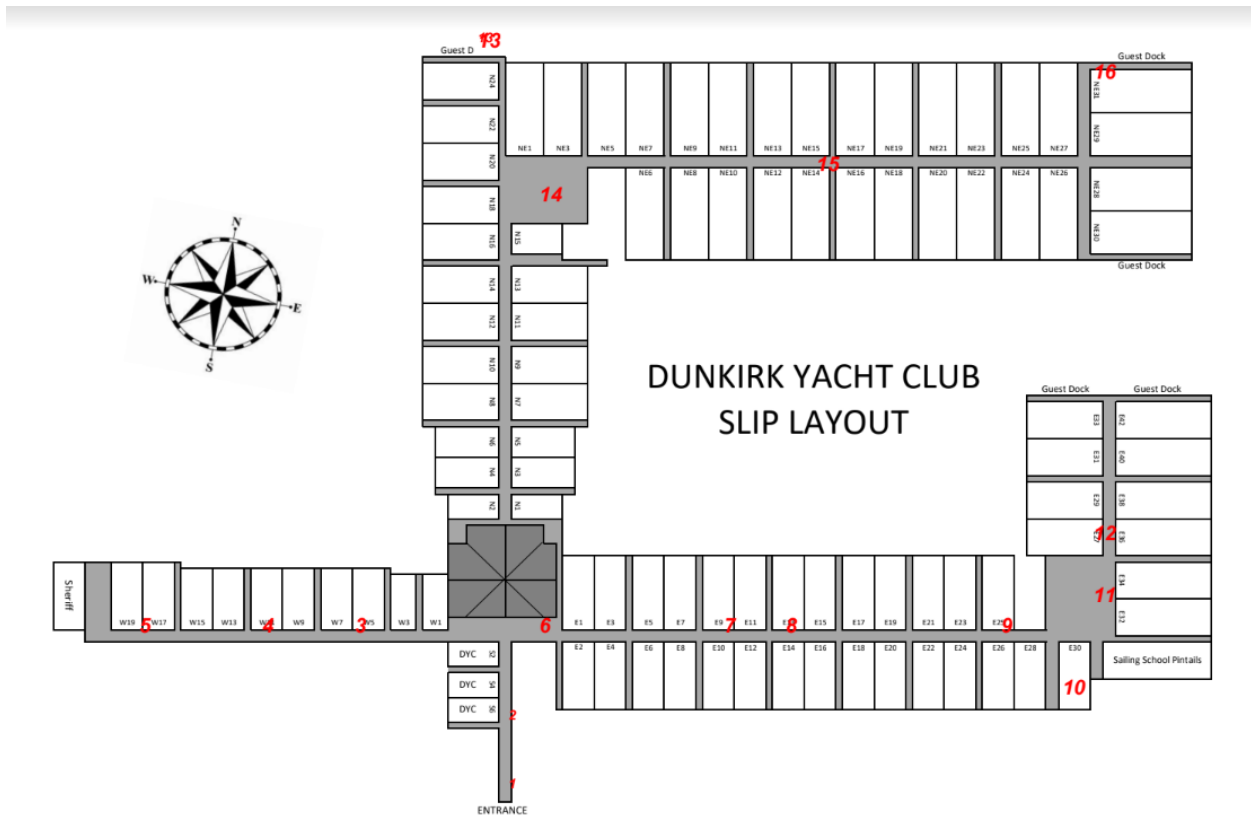

1. An uneven bulge at the connection of main dock to concrete stairs.
2. Uplift damage to dock which is affecting the railing and the new water line.
3. Uplift damage.
4. Missing decking where a previous repair occurred.
5. Missing decking.
6. Uplift damage with missing decking.
7. Uplift damage. (minor)
8. Uplift damage. (minor)
9. Uplift damage with missing decking.
10. Finger is split in two.
11. Major uplift and structural damage along the joint between the Eastside of the deck area and West side of the main dock.
12. Uplift damage.
13. Waterline damage. (maybe abandoned)

15. Uplift damage. (minor)
16. The main dock heading to the gin pole and the guest dock are both leaning heavily, solid but need to be leveled out.
