Mission of the LRP:

- Envision DYC facilities requirements and changes, 1-2, 5, 10 and 20 years from now

- Plan for potential future infrastructure changes to clubhouse, docks, utilities, etc. Set current and future infrastructure standards for repair and/or replacement projects Recommend/manage short term projects (1-2 years) that improve the esthetics, safety, and/or usefulness of the DYC clubhouse and docks (improvement vs repair) Help manage long range capital budget planning for major infrastructure changes/replacement.

Projects Scheduled 2024

2024 Planning: To be moved from LRP to execution phase.

- Rebuild infrastructure and docking on West dock using new electrical infrastructure, install (4) 100-amp GFCI breakers to dock electrical legs
- Project 2: Entry from Main Dock to Clubhouse
 - Convert the west staircase of the clubhouse front deck to ramps
 - Construct a ramp up from the main dock to a platform at the clubhouse deck level
 - Construct 2nd ramp from clubhouse deck level platform to west dock
- Set up cameras for Club member access online
- Evaluate bubbler system

Mission and Planning of the LRP

Areas for Planning:

- Docks Floating Docks Bubbler System Sewer System Water System
 - Clubhouse Internet/Wireless Access Budget

1 to 5 Year Planning:

- Set up Club for remote virtual meetings
- Continue with electrical upgrades to other docks
- Remodel clubhouse bathrooms
- Cosmetic and aesthetic upgrades to the Clubhouse
- Evaluate a section of floating dock

5 to 10 Year Planning:

- Replace/remodel kitchen
- Planning for more demand for electric as electric boats start affecting our club's needs

10 to 20 Year Planning:

• Likely need dock surface and structure replacement project

Education

It was also suggested not to use the pintail this year, and instead will be using a boat which the students and instructor can both be on at the same time while teaching. Board as authorized education to sell the pintails and the trailers to purchase a "shark like" sailboat for education.
